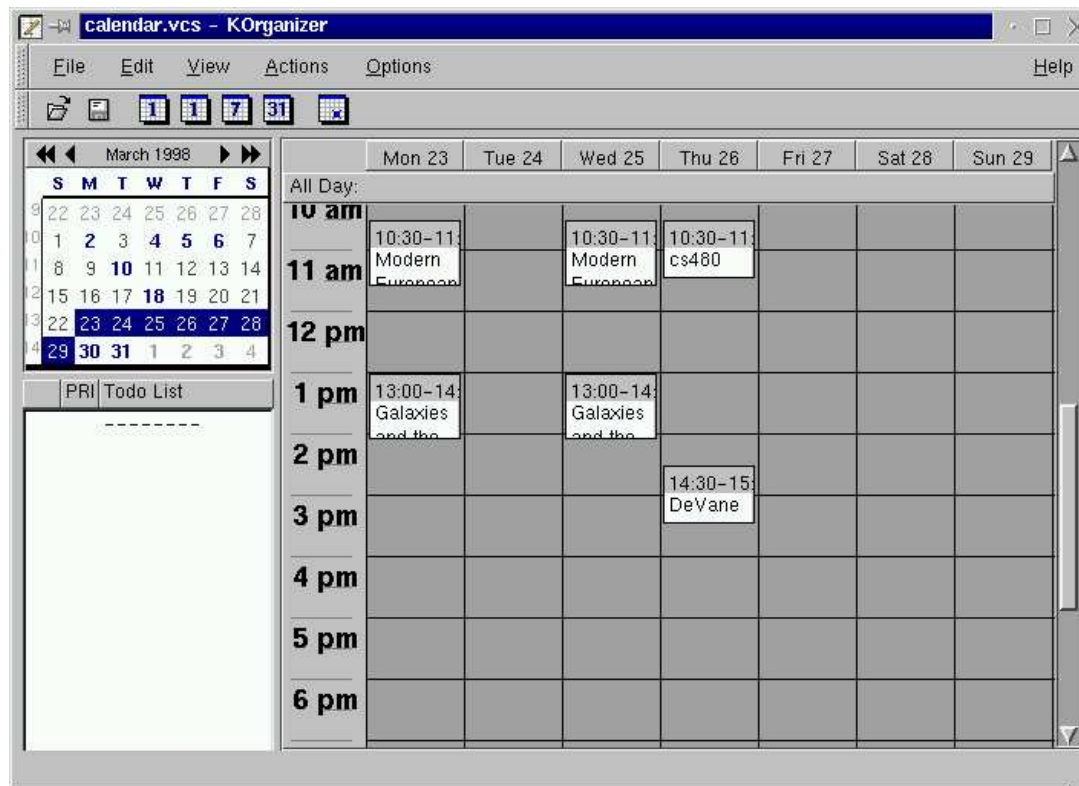

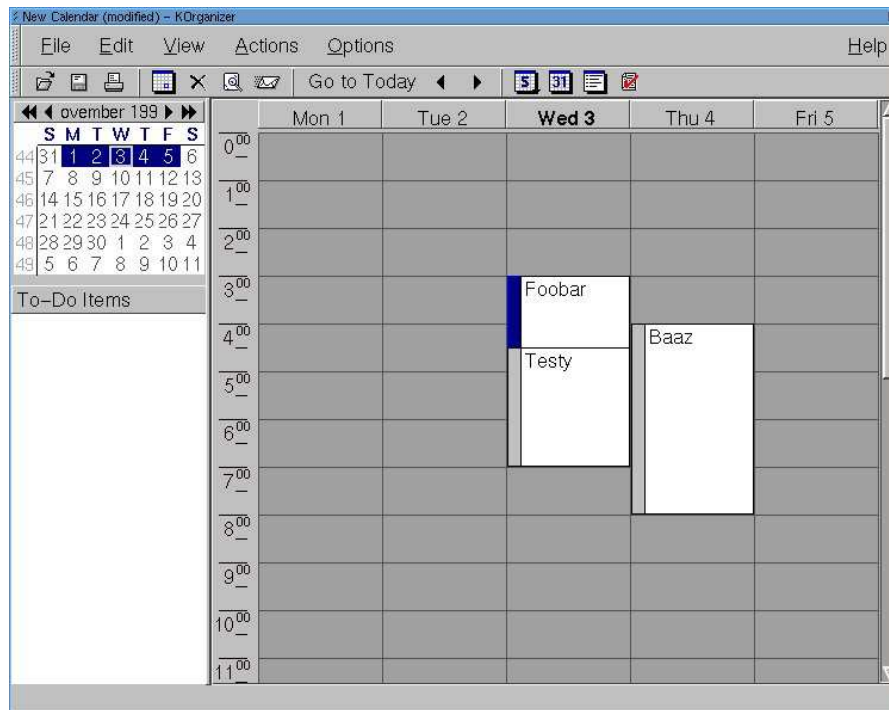

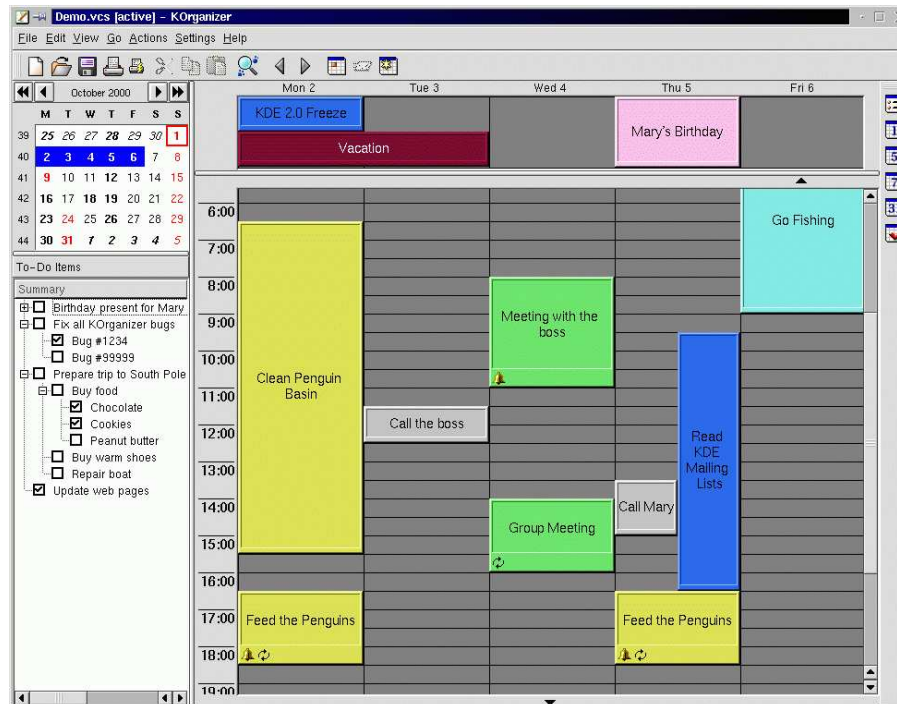

- Hierarchical Todos, HTML Export, Colored Events



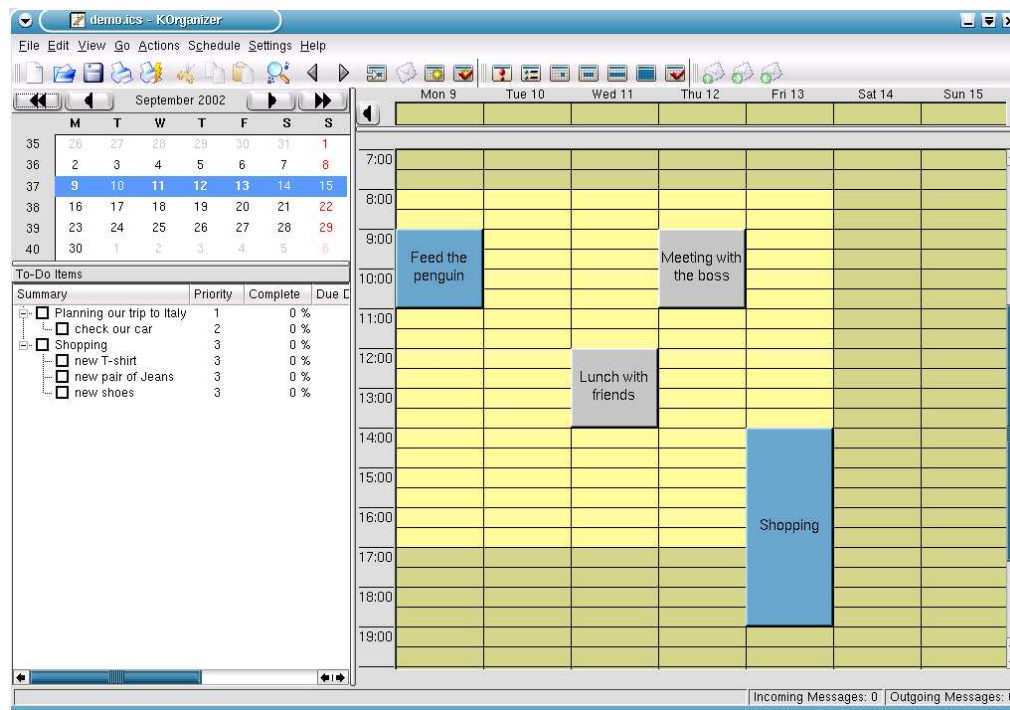
